### REPLACE JET SKI RAMP AND RESTORE AND STABILIZE SCOUR AREAS

Issued by: Town of Gilford, Department of Public Works, 55 Cherry Valley Road, Gilford, NH 03249

The Town of Gilford issued a Rebid Request for Proposals (RFP) on October 28, 2022, to restore/ stabilize the scour areas at and associated with the main boat ramp and jet ski ramp and replace the jet ski ramp at the Glendale Town Docks located at 33 Dock Road in Gilford. All work performed must be done in accordance with the intents of the NHDES Wetlands and Non-Site-Specific Permit 2022-02210. Any questions on the Rebid RFP were due, via electronic submission, by November 2, 2022, at 2PM. The following details question received and the Town's response.

#### Questions/Comments:

1. Can the jet ski lay width be reduced to 12-feet, rather than 15 feet? This may help save costs as 12-foot width is a standard width for some pre-cased planks.

*Response: A 15-foot-wide ramp is preferred. Given initial cost estimates, bids proposing a 12-foot-wide ramp will be accepted and evaluated.*
